# **Important Information before Labor**

## (待產須知 英文)

### ♦ When to go to the hospital?

- Regular contractions: First time pregnancy: three times in 10 minutes; experienced of pregnancy: once per minute.
- Rupture of amniotic sac membranes: amniotic fluid gushing or leaking from the vagina like urine and will wet your underwear, chair and even bed.
- 3. Bloody show Considerate amount of blood leaking from the vagina
- 4. Fetus stops moving: no contractions within 2-3 hours
- A series of continuous and progressive contractions
  Sharp pain in the abdominal region which is stiffened like a basketball.

### ♦ What should you prepare before going into labor?

- 1. Disposable pants (for pregnant woman)
- 2. Sanitary pads (for use during labor)
- 3. ID card of the husband and the wife
- 4. Expectant Mother Health Guide & Health Insurance card
- 5. Bottle for washing vagina
- 6. Clean clothes and bathroom kits
- 7. Tissu paper
- Do not bring too much cash or expensive belongings; 24-hour ATM machine is available in the hospital.

#### Do not panic

- It is not necessary to rush in the hospital if no contractions occurred or only a little red fluid leaking from the vagina.
- The hospital is responsible for the babies' food and clothes during their stay. You can just bring their clothes when leaving the hospital.
