## Esophageal transit study

Department of the test: Nuclear Medicine (NM)

Purpose of the test: To assess esophageal motor function and to detect esophageal motility disorders.

## Notes before the test:

- 1. You will have some radiation in this test.
- 2. You should have nothing to eat or drink 6 hours prior to the test.

## On the day of the test:

- 1. Please check in first at NM service counter.
- 2. This is a two-part test.
  - (1) You will be asked to lie down on the imaging table and to drink a glass of water (about 50 c.c.) that contains a small amount of radioactive tracer. Pictures will be taken immediately after drinking water
  - (2) You will be asked to repeat the same action in sitting position.
- 3. Pictures will be taken for 20 minutes by NM technologist. Please don't move during these pictures.

Total duration of the test: About 60 minutes.

Adverse drug effect of the test: Very rare.
