Venography

Department of the test: Nuclear Medicine (NM)

Purpose of the test:

To detect blood clots and patency of the deep veins in the legs.

Notes before the test:

- 1. You will have some radiation in this test.
- 2. Preparation before your test is not required.
- 3. Please don't bring pregnant women or children with you. We don't want to expose them to unnecessary radiation.

On the day of the test:

- 1. Please check in first at our NM service counter.
- 2. You will be asked to lie down on the imaging bed with the camera positioned above your legs.
- 3. The NM physician or technologist will inject a small amount of radioactive tracer into a vein in each foot.
- 4. Pictures are taken during the injection and for a short time later.

Total duration of the test: About 50 minutes.

Adverse drug effect of the test: Very rare.
