Cholescintigraphy

Department of the test: Nuclear Medicine (NM)

Purpose of the test: to determine the bile flow from the liver to the gut and to see if there is any bile leak or obstruction.

Notes before the test:

- 1. You will have some radiation in this test.
- 2. You should have nothing to eat or drink 8 hours prior to the test.
- 3. For diagnosing biliary atresia or other congenital biliary abnormality, phenobarbital should be taken for 3-5 days and you should have nothing to eat or drink for at least 2-4 hours prior to the test.

Procedure of the test:

- 1. Please check in first at NM service counter.
- 2. NM physician will give you a bolus of radioactive tracer injected into your vein.
- Pictures will be taken continuously for 1 hour by NM technologist. Delayed images may be required on the same day.
- 4. Please don't move during these pictures and follow the orders of NM technologist to continue fasting or to eat food.

Total duration of the test: About 4-6 hours.

Adverse drug effect of the test: Very rare.
