## E.F. plus wall motion

Department of the test: Nuclear Medicine (NM)

Purpose of the test: To evaluate your heart function.

## Notes before the test:

- 1. You will have some radiation in this test.
- 2. Preparation before your test is not required.

## On the day of the test:

- 1. Please check in first at NM service counter.
- 2. You will have a blood labeling agent (stannous ion) injected into your veins by NM physician.
- 3. After a 20-minute break, you will have another bolus of radioactive pertechnetate ion injected into your veins by NM physician.
- 4. After another 20-minutes break, NM technologists will place electrodes and wires on your chest to monitor your heart rate and take pictures of your heart for 30 minutes.
- 5. Please don't move during these pictures.

Total duration of the test: About 1-2 hour.

Adverse drug effect of the test: very rare.
