## Enterogastroesophageal reflux

Department of the test: Nuclear Medicine (NM)

Purpose of the test: To assess enterogastroesophageal reflux.

Notes before the test: You should have nothing to eat or drink 6-8 hours prior to the test.

## On the day of the test:

- 1. Please check in first at NM service counter.
- 2. You will be asked to drink a glass of water (about 250 c.c.) that contains a small amount of radioactive tracer.
- 3. NM technologist will help you lie on the imaging table and NM physician will place the blood pressure cuff on the top of your abdomen at belt level.
- 4. The blood pressure cuff will be inflated and pictures will be taken for 40 minutes. Please don't move during these pictures.

Total duration of the test: About 60 minutes.

Adverse drug effect of the test: Very rare.
